2. PURPOSE

3. DIMENSIONS

Consult with and advise Provincial Works Managers and field staff concerning budgeting maintenance practices and standards, and provide assistance in the Implementation of road maintenance policies and strategies

4. PRINCIPLE ACCOUNTABILITIES

Report to the Supervising Engineer (RAMS) to ensure by regular Inspection that the standards and quality of road have been achieved and validate inspection result from the provinces. Maintain updates of Road Maintenance Inventory and assist intraining.

5. MAJOR DUTIES

- 5.1 To provide assistance in the implementation of road maintenance policies and strategies.
- 5.2 Consult with and advise Provincial Works Managers and field staff concerning budgeting maintenance practices and standards.
- 5.3 To advise in preparation of Highway Maintenance Programs for each province, to help In organization of works and to ascertain the needs and priorities In relation to resources available.
- 5.4 Ensure by regular Inspection that the standards and quality control of road maintenance are been achieved.
- 5.5 To assist the Principal Engineer (Projects) In the organization of supervision works, training and control of direct labor contract work to ensure maximum efficiency.
- 5.6 Liaise with other Branches for the support and training of newly developed Road Maintenance Software and Update and collecting road maintenance data.

- 5.7 Prepare annual programs for road and Inspection, maintenance, repair and replacement and determine the necessary budget allocations.
- 5.8 Represent the best interest of the Department and other duties compatible with qualifications

6. NATURE AND SCOPE

The position is within the Asset Management Branch in Headquarter and reports directly to the Supervising Engineer (RAMS).
